- k. Being a juristic person who signs *Integrity Pact Agreement for Co-operation on Anti-Corruption in Public Procurement (Between Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, Business Operator and Observer)* to be submitted on the technical proposal opening date.
- l. Bidders shall provide written minimum standards of the policy and directions for anti-corruption in relation to procurement together with supporting evidence pursuant to the Notification of the Anti-Corruption Co-operation Committee Concerning Minimum Standards of the Policy and Directions for Anti-Corruption in Relation to Procurement Required to be put in place by the Business Operator, in accordance with Section 19 of the Public Procurement and Supplies Administration Act, B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017).

II. All Bidders should preferably meet the following requirements; failure to so comply may constitute sufficient ground for rejection.

- a. The Bidder shall supply documentary evidence established in accordance with Article B-8. Information to be Submitted with Bid to demonstrate adequately that he is eligible to bid and is qualified to perform the Contract if his bid is accepted. Bidder should also demonstrate his capacity to perform the Work either with or without the use of subcontractor.

A-4. Eligibility of Bidders: Technical Requirements

I. All Bidders shall meet the following requirements; failure to so comply shall constitute sufficient ground for rejection.

- a. Himself or either firm of the joint venture/consortium, having a record of experience in executing at least two (2) turnkey contracts as contractor (not as subcontractor) in overseas country (not his own country) or at least five (5) turnkey contracts as contractor (not as subcontractor) in his own country for supply and installation of power submarine cable system transmission line at a voltage level of 220 kV or above and at least five (5) years of successful operation record.

In addition, a minimum of one (1) turnkey contract from the mentioned two (2) or five (5) turnkey contracts above shall involve submarine cable laying distances of not less than 30 kilometers and include one (1) factory joint.

Further to item a. mentioned above, to meet the requirements of Thai regulations, himself or the joint venture/consortium shall also form an alliance as joint venture or consortium with local firm(s) having an experience in executing at least one (1) turnkey contract as contractor (not as subcontractor) with other Electricity Authorities of Thailand in supply and installation of power submarine cable system transmission line with at least five (5) years of successful operation record.

Experience record of the Bidder or either firm of the joint venture/consortium, including experience record derived from being a firm of other joint venture or consortium in previous project(s) is acceptable. It is not allowed to combine the experience records of each firm of the joint venture/consortium in order to meet the experience requirements.

Integrity Pact

Agreement for Co-operation on Anti-Corruption in Public Procurement (Between Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, Business Operator and Observer)

This Integrity Pact is entered into among Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, a state agency, (hereinafter referred to in this Integrity Pact as “EGAT”) and, the Business Operator, registered as a juristic entity at, having its principal office at, by an authorized signatory acting on behalf of the juristic person as appear on a copy of Office of the Company Limited and Partnership Registration Certificate dated (and a copy of a Power of Attorney dated) attached to this Integrity Pact (hereinafter referred to in this Integrity Pact as the “the Business Operator”) and the Observers, (hereinafter referred to in this Integrity Pact as the “Observer”).

Whereas EGAT intends to execute a procurement contract on Supply and Construction of Submarine Cable System 230 kV. Khanom - Ko. Samui (hereinafter referred to in this Integrity Pact as the “Project”) pursuant to procedures stipulated under laws and regulations relating to public procurement, and desires to establish a co-operation on anti-corruption in the procurement of the Project, to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness in government budget expenditure and a more transparency, integrity and equitable public procurement operation. Thus, only Business Operator who signs this Integrity Pact shall be entitled to participate in procurement process of this Project.

Whereas EGAT and the Business Operator both agree that the Observer has a significant role in the co-operation on anti-corruption in the procurement process of the Project.

EGAT, the Business Operator and the Observer, hereby execute this Integrity Pact declaring the co-operation in compliance with the notification of the Anti-Corruption Co-operation Committee concerning guidelines and procedures in relation to the execution of the program for co-operation on anti-corruption in public procurement, the form of an integrity pact, selection of observers and preparation of the report under section 17 and section 18 of the Public Procurement and Supplies Administration Act B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017) announced on July 5, B.E. 2561 and its amendment or new announcement (hereinafter referred to in this Integrity Pact as the “Notification”) as well as to comply with the terms and conditions as follows:

1. EGAT

EGAT strongly intends to apply ethical principle as a supporting mechanism to enhance co-operation among all parties to ensure that the procurement procedures of the Project is corruption-free and without any misconduct, which leads to the efficiency and effectiveness in government budget expenditure and brings true benefits to the country and the public. EGAT hereby undertakes to comply with the Integrity Pact as follows:

- 1.1 Disclose information relating to the procurement, in accordance with the processes including but not limited to (1) Project procurement plan (2) scope of work (Terms of Reference: TOR) (3) announcement for invitation to bid, draft of bidding documents (4) announcement of medium cost (Reference Price) (5) list of recipients/ buyers of bidding documents (6) list of bidders (7) brief conclusion of bid proposals (8) list of bidders who pass the qualifications and technical proposal. (9) name of the successful bidder and contract price (10) contract (11) contract amendments (12) delivery of work (13) acceptance of work (14) payment (15) complaint and investigation results. This information shall be published on the EGAT's website and Electronic Government Procurement: e- GP's website, permitting the public to participate in the monitoring of the public procurement process.
- 1.2 Treat all Business Operator, who participate as the bidders, fairly and equally, e.g. provide the same information to all bidders. In case it is necessary to include any additional conditions or to amend any specific qualifications considered to be significant, which is not mentioned in the original bidding documents, EGAT shall execute additional bidding documents, inform in writing to all recipients/ buyers of bidding documents, and shall not provide any confidential or favorable information to any specific bidder that may cause a disadvantage to either bidder in the bidding process or during the performance of the contract in order to promote fair competition.
- 1.3 Take measures to prevent any practices or actions between EGAT or its directors or managing officers or officials and the Business Operator, intending to tender proposals in the Project or participating in price proposal or being the contractor in the Project, to such degree that other persons or the public may consider as corrupt or lead to malfeasance in the performance of its duty or in public procurement process of the Project, including measures to prevent any demand, take promise for or accept any bribe or any other advantages, either for themselves or for any person, and shall not set up any condition or consideration that shall bestow a privilege of obtaining the right to execute the contract with EGAT to any bidders or any participants of the Project, or discriminate any bidders or any participants of the Project from fair competition.

- 1.4 Allow and facilitate the Observer to participate in the observation of in the operation or meetings relating to public procurement and disclose information and documents relating to public procurement to the Observer throughout the Project and in every step including the following processes: (1) Project procurement plan (2) preparation of the Terms of Reference (TOR) (3) drafting of bidding documents and announcement for invitation to bid (4) estimation of medium cost (Reference Price) (5) examination of bidders eligibility, examination of technical and price proposal, price negotiation, appeal determination or any processes of the procurement (6) execution of the contract (7) contract amendments (8) inspection and acceptance of the work according to the procurement contract. EGAT shall arrange meeting(s) with the Observer and shall provide any sufficient information relating to any meeting of EGAT or between EGAT and the bidders or participants or the contractor of the Project to the Observer in advance in order to efficiently perform and participate in the observation.
- 1.5 Take measures and set up convenient means for any witness to access and report any violation of this Integrity Pact or any actions inconsistency with this Integrity Pact of directors, managing officers or officials involving in public procurement to EGAT or other relating authorities, e. g. the National Anti-Corruption Commission, Office of Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission, Department of Special Investigation or Office of the Auditor General for consideration accordingly. EGAT can also take disciplinary action against its officials who have involved such corrupt practices.

2. Business Operator

Whereas the Business Operator realize that ethical Business Operator plays a significant role in the co-operation on anti-corruption in public procurement. In order to ensure that all procurement processes are free from corruption and any other misconduct as intended by EGAT. The Business Operator hereby undertakes to comply with the Integrity Pact as follows:

- 2.1 Comply with measures and processes necessary to prevent corruption in public procurement and promote good faith, transparency and fairness in government procurement by imposing of anti-corruption policies as well as communicating such policies throughout the Business Operator's organization.
- 2.2 Shall not give, offer or promise directly or indirectly any bribes or benefits to its directors, managing officers, officials, officials involving in public procurement of the Project, participants in price proposal or other bidders, to induce to act or forbearance to act or delay any action wrongfully, or colluding in submitting proposals to EGAT, or in the procurement processes or the implementation of the contract either before or during the bidding process and once the contract is signed.

- 2.3 Allow and facilitate the Observer to participate in the observation, access to data and documents and inspect all processes of the Project including acceptance of the work in the same manner as EGAT.
- 2.4 In the event that the Business Operator enter into the contract of the Project, the Business Operator shall be responsible for any actions of its sub-contractor(s) (if any) as if the sub-contractor(s) have performed virtually as the Business Operator and shall ensure that such sub-contractor(s) perform as if (he/she is a contractor) (they are contractor) of this Integrity Pact.
- 2.5 In case where the Business Operator witness any violation of this Integrity Pact or any actions inconsistency with this Integrity Pact or any behavior which may deem corrupt or leads to corruption of participants in price proposal, bidders or contractor or any representatives in this Project, the Business Operator shall report to EGAT or other relating authorities, e.g. the National Anti-Corruption Commission, Office of Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission, Department of Special Investigation or Office of the Auditor General for consideration accordingly.

3. Observer

Whereas the Observer acknowledges that an independent, neutral and ethical Observer, who has expertise in above mentioned Project, is an important mechanism to prevent corruption in public procurement. In order to ensure that project shall be free from corruption or any misconduct, the Observer hereby undertakes to comply with the Integrity Pact as follows:

- 3.1 Participate in the observation of the procurement processes throughout the project and in every step including (1) Project procurement plan (2) drafting of the Terms of reference (TOR) (3) drafting of bidding documents and announcement for invitation to bid (4) estimation of medium cost (Reference Price) (5) examination of bidders eligibility, examination of technical and price proposal, price negotiation, appeal determination or any processes of the procurement (6) execution of the contract (7) contract amendments (8) inspection and acceptance of the work according to the procurement contract;
- The Observer has the right to access all data and documents relating to the Project, EGAT, and Participants in price proposal, bidders or contractor shall cooperate to facilitate in providing the information.

- 3.2 Act independently, honestly, fairly and provide suggestions based on areas of expertise, but without right to vote and would not do anything wrongfully which could interrupt the procurement process.
- 3.3 The Observer and its first degree relatives shall has no interests or relationship with EGAT, person or juristic person or company and company's directors who participate in the tender of proposals.
- 3.4 Maintaining the Confidentiality as follows:
 - 3.4.1 Shall not disclose any documents and information obtained from being the Observer of the Project unless otherwise in accordance with the guidelines expressed in this Integrity Pact and disclosure according to the procurement procedures required by law.
 - 3.4.2 Shall not use any documents related to the Project for personal interests or wrongfully used or for the benefit of others.
 - 3.4.3 Shall be liable for any damages arising out of disclosure or use of trade secret without written consent from the Anti-Corruption Commission.
- 3.5 Shall execute the confidentiality agreement and no conflict of interest attached to the Notification purposely use for EGAT as supporting documents of this Integrity Pact.
- 3.6 Shall proceed in accordance with the Observer's operational guidelines including reporting the observation result and preparing of Project evaluation report to the Anti-Corruption Commission according to the procedures specified in the Notification.
- 3.7 In case where EGAT, any bidders, contractor or representatives violates this Integrity Pact, or any corrupt practices or illegal activities has been found, the Observer shall inform EGAT to provide explanation or clarification within a time period. If EGAT does not do so, the Observer shall inform the Anti-Corruption Cooperation Committee, in order to report to the public, and can also inform other related authorities, e.g. the National Anti-Corruption Commission, Office of Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission, Department of Special Investigation or Office of the Auditor General to consider accordingly.

This Integrity Pact is executed in three (3) identical counterparts for EGAT, Business Operator and Observer. The Parties have read and fully understood the content of this Integrity Pact. The Parties hereby signed and affix seal (if any) in the presence of witnesses.

If the Bidder has registered as a VAT registrant, he shall submit EGAT an evidence of VAT registration. On the contrary, if the Bidder is not registered as a VAT registrant, he shall inform EGAT whether he will register as a VAT registrant or not.

In case the Bidder is a consortium, each member of the consortium shall fill in the Confirmation Form provided for consortium Bidders.

- af. Filled-in Documentary List and documents required according to Additional Regulation.
- ag. *Integrity Pact Agreement for Co-operation on Anti-Corruption in Public Procurement (Between Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, Business Operator and Observer)* signed by the Bidder.
- ah. Bidder's minimum standards of the policy and directions for anti-corruption in relation to procurement, together with the completely filled out Anti-Corruption Compliance Checklist as provided, and supporting evidence.

Where the Bidder holding a certification under ISO 37001 Anti-Bribery Management Systems, certification from the Thai Private Sector Collective Action against Corruption (CAC Certified), or any certification as prescribed by the Anti-Corruption Co-operation Committee, shall be deemed to have satisfied the minimum standards of the policy and directions for anti-corruption in relation to procurement. Such certification documents may be submitted as part of the bid.

Such minimum standards of the policy and directions for anti-corruption in relation to procurement, or the certification, shall remain valid and effective from the technical proposal opening date.

Should the Bidder fail to submit any of the document described above and neglect to submit the same to EGAT within the time as specified by EGAT, such failure shall be sufficient reason for rejection of his bid.

Verbal statements made by the Bidder at any time regarding quality, quantity, or arrangement of Equipment will not be considered.

If alternate Equipment is indicated in the bid, it shall be understood that EGAT will have the option of selecting any one of the alternates so indicated and such selection shall not be a cause for extra compensation or extension of time.

In case the Bidder proposes alternate Equipment, with the condition to supply any one of the alternates so indicated at his option, such bid will be considered conditional and may be considered sufficient reasons for rejection.

B-9. Deviations from Specifications

Unless otherwise provided in the Specifications, the quality of Equipment and workmanship shall comply in all respects with the Standards required under the bidding documents.
